- I. The "Rental Housing Service" of Kai Ping Culinary School (hereinafter the "School") are exclusively available for students from other counties and cities, providing rental information services and assisting with related rental applications. The number of service slots is limited and available until filled.
- II. During the rental period, the School is not responsible for managing daily living; students are expected to manage themselves. Parents are urged to pay close attention to the students' lifestyle and behavior during the rental period.
- III. Dormitory Fee:

Twin room (1 bed): NTD 6,000 per month

- 1. The lease term is one year (12 months) from September 1st to August 31st of the following year (move-in and move-out dates are as notified by the School).
- 2. The first payment includes an additional two-month deposit of NTD 6,000*2, totaling NTD 12,000.
- 3. Rent payments and refunds are uniformly processed according to Kai Ping Culinary School's payment and refund regulations. Failure to pay or refund on time is considered a forfeiture.
- IV. Dormitory fees do not include electricity costs (using prepaid card), with a card fee of NT\$100. Please purchase at the Dormitory Management Center. The card is non-refundable after use, and whether to purchase with roommates should be considered individually. (The dormitory is equipped with a card topup machine.)
- V. Dormitory rooms provide a bed (mattress not included), desk, chair, and wardrobe. Personal bedding and other items must be prepared by the students.
- VI. Considering the independence and safety of dormitory, applicants must be capable of self-care and follow group living regulations. The School may hold special discussions if necessary.
- VII. All dormitory beds are upper bunks. Applicants should consider their health condition. Those with specific conditions (e.g., sleepwalking, epilepsy, etc.) should not apply.
- VIII. Smoking, drinking, and causing disturbances that affect the living environment or safety of others in the dormitory are strictly prohibited. Violations will be dealt with according to the School's dormitory management regulations. Verified offenses will be handled through legal education on violating the community life covenant (legal actions will be taken as appropriate), and the offender will lose the right to reapply for residency.
- IX. Dormitory Withdrawal Regulations:
 - Violation of the Student Dormitory Guidance and Management Regulations.

Failure to improve conditions after advice from teachers and administrators may result in the loss of residency eligibility for the new term.
- 4. Allocation of student beds is managed by the Officers' Office of the School. Beds may not be changed without the Authority's consent.
- XI. After applying for residency, the School will provide the applicant's information. The Kai Ping Culinary School Admission Section will notify applicants of the move-in procedures.
