

# Required documents for foreign students:

- I. Highest academic degree certificates and transcripts from foreign schools (Documents in languages other than Chinese or English must be accompanied by a Chinese or English translation).
- II. Financial proof of assets exceeding NTD 900,000 from parents or other legal guardians, verified by diplomatic missions abroad.
- III. Proof of financial resources sufficient for studying in Taiwan (at least three months of living expenses).
- IV. Proof of qualifications of the guardian in Taiwan (not required for adult foreign students).
- V. Power of attorney for the guardian in Taiwan, authorized and verified by parents or other legal guardians through an overseas mission (not required for adult foreign students).
- VI. Consent form of the guardian in Taiwan notarized by a court in Taiwan (not required for adult foreign students).

Note 1: The highest academic degree certificates from foreign schools, except those issued by overseas Taiwanese schools, should be processed in accordance with the regulations set by the Ministry of Education.

Note 2: The guardian in Taiwan must hold the nationality of the Republic of China, and provide a criminal record certificate issued by the police authorities and a list of the total amount of various types of income exceeding NTD 900,000 for the latest year, issued by the tax collection authorities.

Note 3: Each qualified person can only serve as the guardian for one student from Hong Kong or Macau, except for school principals, directors of school corporations, or board members, who may serve as the guardian for up to five students from Hong Kong and Macau.
