Required documents for students from Hong Kong

and Macau:

- I. Educational certificates and transcripts:
 - 1. For Hong Kong or Macau: Highest educational certificate and transcripts from schools in Hong Kong and Macau, processed according to the regulations for verification and recognition of educational credentials from Hong Kong and Macau.
 - 2.For Mainland China: Highest educational certificate and transcripts from schools in Mainland China, to be handled according to the regulations for recognition of educational credentials from Mainland China.
 - 3.For foreign schools: Highest academic degree certificates and transcripts from foreign schools, which should be verified by the diplomatic mission abroad; if the documents are in languages other than Chinese or English, a verified translation in Chinese or English must be provided, or the original documents must be verified first, followed by notarization of the translation by a notary in Taiwan. However, for degrees from foreign schools or branch campuses located in Mainland China, they must be notarized by a notary public in Mainland China and verified by an institution established or designated by the Executive Yuan or by a commissioned private organization.
 - 4.Educational credentials from overseas Taiwanese schools and Taiwan businessmen's schools in Mainland China are recognized as equivalent to the corresponding levels in Taiwan.
- II. Hong Kong and Macau passports or permanent residency certificates.
- III. Original documents proving continuous residence abroad.
- IV. Proof of financial resources sufficient for studying in Taiwan (at least three months of living expenses).
- V. Proof of qualifications of the guardian in Taiwan (not required for adult students from Hong Kong and Macau).
- VI. Power of attorney for the guardian in Taiwan, authorized and verified by parents or other legal guardians through an overseas mission (not required for adult students from Hong Kong and Macau).
- VII. Consent form of the guardian in Taiwan notarized by a court in Taiwan (not required for adult students from Hong Kong and Macau).
- Note 1: The guardian in Taiwan must be a citizen of the Republic of China with a registered residence in Taiwan and provide a criminal record certificate issued by the police authorities and a list of the total amount of various types of income exceeding NTD 900,000 for the latest year, issued by the tax collection authorities.
- Note 2: Each qualified person can only serve as the guardian for one student from Hong Kong or Macau, except for school principals, directors of school corporations, or board members, who may serve as the guardian for up to five students from Hong Kong and Macau.
